They are made to order by Oxford Green Roofs Ltd and delivered in flat pack format with full instructions for an appropriately skilled person to assemble. All the wood is supplied ready cut to size and all the fixings are included. If necessary we at Oxford Green Roofs Ltd can take on this build service if the customer wishes.

The soil and plants are not included in the basic kit, to enable the customer to choose the plants. It is possible for us to design the green roof or to leave it for the customer who loves gardening to try out their own planting scheme.
